Waitakere Forest and Bird 2023 Lecture Series

Exploring threats to seabirds from their own perspective

Thursday 20th July 7.30 pm

Ariel-Micaiah Heswall is doing her PhD at the University of Auckland researching how seabirds perceive the threats of lights and plastics. Her interest in birds in general, but specifically in seabirds, started during her undergraduate at the University of Auckland studying marine science.

An honours degree in Biological Sciences followed, studying seabird sensory ecology and how the sizes of seabird sensory features correlate with bycatch numbers. Her most recent work received quite a bit of media attention last year when a high number of seabirds were found sitting dazed and confused under street lights in Auckland city.
