Ever wondered what that double garage is that sits next to the Waiatarua Play Centre at the bottom of the drive at the Waiatarua Community Hall?

Affectionately known as 'Badgers,' it belongs to the Waiatarua Performing Arts Trust, & is a storage space for set construction materials and a few props & costumes.

'Badgers' is in need of a clean-up and the trust is discussing ideas to keep out the mould & mildew that all us bush dwellers are familiar with.

Built in the 1980s by the Waiatarua Drama Club, my first memory of it was in 1989. As a 21-year-old, I acted in the first play I was involved in at Waiatarua - The Nerd - an American comedy by Larry Shue. I remember rehearsing in the upstairs room there and there was a framed picture on the wall depicting a group of badgers. The picture can still be found among the props.



We even had a ghostly experience there at midnight. We must

have been having a couple of glasses of wine after rehearsal when we felt a presence in the room with us. I haven't felt it on any other occasion in the 26 years since.

The drama club went into recess for more than a decade, but was reinvigorated in the new century. For legal reasons a new structure had to be formed, so the new name Waiatarua Performing Arts Trust (WPAT) was born. WPAT is currently considering a programme of plays for 2015, so watch this space. Well done to those attending. This month also sees the brigade doing our annual first aid training.

Fire Safety - What to do in a fire

- •Crawl low and fast to escape smoke. 'Get Down, Get Low, Get out.'
- •Shut doors behind you to slow the spread of fire
- Meet at the planned meeting place.
- •Once out, stay out never go back inside.
- •Phone the Fire Service from a safe phone. Tell the Fire Service•house number•street•nearest intersection•suburb and city

What to do after a fire:

Do not enter your damaged house unless you have to and have been advised it is safe to do so. The Fire Service will check the water, electricity and gas supplies and either arrange to have them disconnected or advise you what action to take.

As I write this, that's how it's been for the past few days and today, after getting jammed in a dozen traffic queues and over an hour getting home, I couldn't quite believe I live in such an awesome spot. As soon as I walked in the door and out to the courtyard to the sun filtering through the greenery from a hundred angles, the urban crawl to get home all seemed worthwhile. Perhaps the enjoyment at being home in Waiatarua today was heightened from sitting through a rather long, but regular, bi-monthly meeting last night of the several residents and ratepayers associations of the Waitakere Ranges, hosted by our extremely hard working Local Board at Glen Eden.

We heard about the ten year budget plan of Len Brown's team and as the presentation progressed, it was salient to note the valiant initiatives that have fallen by the wayside - developed by previous governing bodies cooperating with caring locals - initiatives that are locally grown and reflect the knowledge of how to care for this precious area. The most concerning theme to me was that all the decisions are now taken in Queen Street by people who may never have visited Waiatarua and so wouldn't necessarily understand what makes this place special and how it needs to be cared for so that it is retained.

It's also been great catching up with a few Waiatarua locals over the break and getting some perspective on their life in Waiatarua. I went to couple of celebrations and the WRRA also had Brett, the new owner of Elevations, come and see us. He's getting through an enormous amount of work bringing it back up to a high standard with a great menu. I thoroughly recommend you forget all of your previous experiences there and call in to see what he's up to.
