From the Editor CATASTROPHIC WRRA COMMITTEE COLLAPSE

Ah! Now that I have your attention...

The WRRA had an AGM and committee elections on 19 February, and in this issue I had hoped to be proudly announcing the names of the principal officers elected at that meeting, namely President, Secretary and Treasurer. Instead, we have a committee in a crisis with no volunteers for any of these positions, a disappointingly small turnout of residents on the night, and only one new WRRA membership application.

It is not too extravagant to say that this is a crisis for the WRRA. If we don't get people to stand for election to the committee there is a real danger that the Association will have to go into recess. I think this would be a disaster for Waiatarua, because;

We would no longer have a voice with the Waitakere City Council:

We would have no means of running the Community Hall;

The newsletter would disappear;

The Community Library would probably continue, but be thrown totally on its own resources as far as administration, maintenance etc. is concerned; and

There would be no-one organising social events, such as community breakfasts, quiz nights, debates etc.

On the plus side, those remaining as committee members are Peter Casey, Rita Steel, Sue Bowers, Ross Forbes and myself.

A special word to members of the community who have been on the committee in the past— please consider whether you would like to do it again. We could certainly use your experience.

We have a great community here and we are lucky to live in such a beautiful area. If we want the WRRA to continue we need people to work on the committee. If you care about our community and want it to stay as the beautiful place it is now, contact our immediate Past President, Peter Casey, now and offer your services. You can reach him on president@waiatarua.org.nz. The work really isn't too onerous. We really want to emphasise that not all monthly meetings need to be in person - some could be online, which might reduce the burden, for example, if the meetings at the hall were bi-monthly. There are many ways it can be simplified so that we can keep the hall in community hands and have a voice where needed. Please think about it.

That there is a NZ Post box, conveniently located near the Waiatarua Community Hall (911 West Coast Rd) which is cleared every day?

We've already lost a bus service here. If the post box is not used regularly, it will be yet another thing

that we lose. Let's make sure we hold on to it!




